P Festival Parking

...in Denmark Road on the side of the road running from the Chequers Public House to Telegraph Street (West side). If cars are parked on both sides, the bus cannot get through. There will be traffic cones indicating the zone in auestion.

...in Rampton Road along the side of the Village Green. Parking in this area causes congestion and stops the flow of traffic. Again, cones will be placed in the area.



Safety over the weekend
