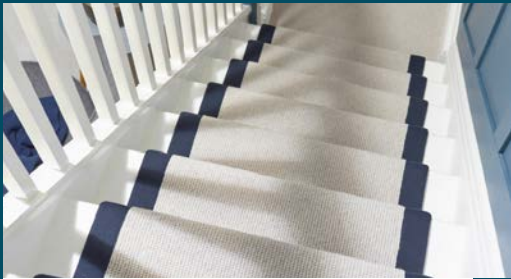

## **P** Festival Parking

There is some on-street parking available in Cottenham but these spaces will be under severe pressure during the Festival.

We will have a restricted number of parking spaces for Blue Badge holders along the road closure by the Village Green.

### **PLEASE DO NOT PARK...**

...in Denmark Road on the side of the road running from the Chequers Public House to Telegraph Street (West side). If cars are parked on both sides, the bus cannot get through. There will be traffic cones indicating the zone in question.

...in Rampton Road along the side of the Village Green. Parking in this area causes congestion and stops the flow of traffic. Again, cones will be placed in the area.

## **♻️** Reducing Plastic

As at previous Festivals we will be using reusable plastic 'glasses' for wine, beer, Pimm's and soft drinks served from our bars and this will save over 2,000 plastic cups from landfill.

There will be a £2 deposit to pay when you buy a drink, which will be refunded when you return your 'glass'. Or if you want, you can keep the glass for another drink later in the weekend. Whilst you may want to take your glass home as a souvenir, it is better for the environment and increases the sustainability of the Festival if you bring it back to be reused rather than keep it.

## **!** Safety over the weekend

We have many safety measures in place, including trained stewards in high visibility jackets, equipped with walkie talkies. Fire extinguishers will be available in marquees and around the Festival site. First aiders will also be present for the duration of the Festival.

To ensure you stay safe, please follow any instructions from stewards and people running activities. Please also remember that parents and carers remain responsible for the children in their care at all times.

Should you have any concerns about any aspect of the Festival please alert a steward or go to the Control Tent - there will be someone there to help.
